This is a picture that was sent to me by a lady from North Carolina which, unlike most I receive, has an air of authenticity about it. The photo was taken with a Sony Cybershot 3.2 mp in Conover, North Carolina on July 16th, 2005. Notice the shadowy image of a little girl standing directly behind the baby (especially clear in the close-up at right). The woman who took the photo didn't notice the little girl when she took the photo and claims that her and the baby were the only ones home at the time. In a follow-up investigation, she told me there is no history of paranormal activity in the home but the woman's family has had a number of paranormal incidents in their life that leads me to surmise that she might somehow be prone to attracting entities.

I've had this photo examined by a photo expert friend who excels at detecting fraud and determining photo anomalies and he was stumped, suggesting that this may, in fact, be a genuine apparition.

What's interesting about this particular photo is that it was one of ten the mother shot and the only one with an apparition in it. It was also the only one with a stuck shutter (which explains the motion blur). Could common camera malfunctions sometimes be the very mechanism by which paranormal energy is inadvertently captured?
