This remarkable photo was taken in January, 2012 in Skipton, England by the mother of the little girl in the photo. The woman snapped the picture while her daughter was being held by the woman's mother, (the child's maternal grandmother), and noticed the semi-transparent image of what appears to be a person behind and to the left of them. The woman, along with several family members, all insist the apparition looks like the woman's deceased grandmother, though, unfortunately they did not have an image available to compare it to.

In looking over the metafile data on this photo, it shows a half second exposure time and an ISO of just 80, which explains both the fuzzy quality of the photo and its general darkness. However, I have noticed that these apparitions seem to appear more frequently when one is using longer exposure times. Could exposure time be a key to capturing evidence of the paranormal, or are there possibly other factors involved? It's definitely a theory that requires further study. *(Photo used with permission.
